






- → REGION I HISTORY
 - → 1975 1976 Total of 9 DRB Tunnels
 - → 1977 1988 Total of 30 DRB Hydro, Water/Sewer, Airport Region II
 - → 1989 1992 Highways Started
 - → 1993 Rapid Growth of Hwys Plus vertical Construction
 - →2001 Over 150 projects / year being added to the 1000

Region I DRB Tunnel, Highway & Building Projects Only






Region I DRB Projects 1975-2010

- **→**CONTRACT DOCUMENTS
 - → Public agencies dictate contract form
 - → Federal State County City
 - → Variety of Districts within above Schools, Utilities
 - → Thousands of different contracts
 - Federal & State Statutes along with Case Law can supersede contract provisions



- → PROCUREMENT METHODS
 - Historically DBB Design, Bid, Build
 - → Design-Build
 - GCCM General Contractor Construction Manager
 - Design Finance Build Operate



- → DRB SPECIFICATIONS / OPERATING PROCEDURES
 - Wide variety of DRB specifications and operating procedures
 - → Always review these and verify the nine elements are contained



- → DISPUTE AVOIDANCE AND PREVENTION
 - → First meeting of DRB schedule time for discussion of key elements / procedures / possibly a 2 – 4 hour training session
 - Discuss the concept of advisory or informal hearing



- → DISPUTE AVOIDANCE AND PREVENTION
 - Urge the parties to hold the first meeting at the beginning of the project
 - Attend the weekly owner/engineer/contractor meeting
 - Review carefully standard documents RFI's, submittals, change order logs, schedule updates
 - ask questions





- → DISPUTE AVOIDANCE AND PREVENTION
 - Conduct the site tour prior to the DRB meeting
 - → Ask probing questions





- → DISPUTE AVOIDANCE AND PREVENTION
 - Project Success Requires 3 "C"s
 - → Competency
 - → Communication
 - → Cooperation
